RESPECT Code of Conduct Parents/Spectators

We all bear a collective responsibility to set a good example and help provide a positive environment in which children can learn and enjoy the game.

Our club supports the FA's Respect programme and we ask that you play your part and observe The FA's Respect Code of Conduct for spectators at all times.

Play your part and support The FA's Code of Respect:

- Have fun; it's what we're all here for!
- Celebrate effort and good play from both sides
- Always respect the Referee and coaches and encourage players to do the same
- Stay behind the touchline and within the Designated Spectators' Area (where provided)
- When players make mistakes, offer them encouragement to try again next time
- Never engage in, or tolerate offensive, insulting or abusive language or behaviour

I understand that if I do not follow the Code, I may be:

- Issued with a verbal warning or asked to leave
- Required to meet with the club committee, league or CFA Welfare Officer
- Obliged to undertake an FA education course
- Requested not to attend future games, be suspended or have my membership removed
- Required to leave the club along with any dependents and/or issued a fine.

In addition, the club would also request that you refrain from any negative commenting on any match, manager/coach, referee or players on any social networking site.
